## **GUIDE TO LOYOLA (Located in the City of Green)**

### **From Cleveland Area:**

Take 77 south towards Canton to Arlington Road Exit, turn right onto Arlington, proceed south to the 5300 block of Arlington to Killinger Road, turn right on Killinger and go about 1/2 mile to our driveway on the left.

### **From Canton Area:**

Take 77 north towards Akron to Arlington Road Exit, turn left onto Arlington, proceed south to the 5300 block of Arlington to Killinger Road, turn right on Killinger and go about 3/4 mile to our driveway on the left.

**ABBOT CLEMENT ZELEZNIK, OSB  
RESIDENT CHAPLAIN  
RETREAT DIRECTOR**

Prior to his retirement, Abbot Clement served as Abbot of Saint Andrew Abbey in Cleveland, Ohio for seven years. He now serves as the Chaplain-in-Residence at Loyola Retreat House in Clinton (City of Green), Ohio, which is in affiliation with the Benedictine Monks of Saint Andrew Abbey.

Abbot Clement earned his bachelor’s degree from St. John’s University in Minnesota and holds master’s degrees in Physics (University of Notre Dame), Religious Education (Loyola University) and Spirituality (Duquesne University). He studied under Fr. Adrian Van Kaam.

He was ordained in 1959 and, shortly thereafter, joined the faculty of Cleveland’s Benedictine High School where he taught physics and theology. While a teacher at Benedictine, he was a popular class moderator and served as Chaplain, as well as coach of the tennis and cross-country teams.

Abbot Clement has been a novice master for twenty years and has been involved with retreats for students, lay adults, and consecrated religious. He has also been a much sought after Spiritual Director for many priests, religious, and lay persons.

Abbot Clement translated the book, “*To My Priests*,” a book of confidences from our Lord through His servant, Concepción Cabrera de Armida, given to priests during the Mexican Revolution (1927-1931).
