Executive Director Georgette Jackson joined Joseph's Home in 2007. She brings more than 20 years of experience in management, including leadership, finance, advocacy and administrative systems management. As executive director, she oversees administration, management and entity-wide development of the organization on a day-to-day basis.

She previously served as an intake specialist at Rosary Hall at St. Vincent Charity Medical Center in Cleveland. Rosary Hall specializes in treating alcoholism and drug dependency. Prior to that, Ms. Jackson served as the interim executive director for ORCA House Inc., one of the oldest African American recovery centers in the country, and as the director of admissions and marketing for Hillside Plaza, a long-term care facility in Cleveland. She has also held sales and marketing positions at MBNA (now part of Bank of America) and UnitedHealthcare, a provider of health benefits plans and services.

Ms. Jackson is a graduate of Cleveland State University, earning both a bachelor's degree in psychology and a master's degree in labor relations and human resources. She also received a Catholic Charities Health and Human Services executive leadership program certificate from John Carroll University. Her volunteer commitments include serving as an advisory board member for Project Save, a marketing committee member for New Avenues to Independence, Inc. and a board member for Catholic Community Connections.

Joseph's Home, a Ministry of the Sisters of Charity Health System, provides a nurturing, caring environment for men without resources who have acute medical needs, helping them heal and achieve independence. It is the only facility of its kind in Northeast Ohio. In 2007, Joseph's Home was selected for the Building Healthy Communities award from the St. Luke's Foundation of Cleveland.

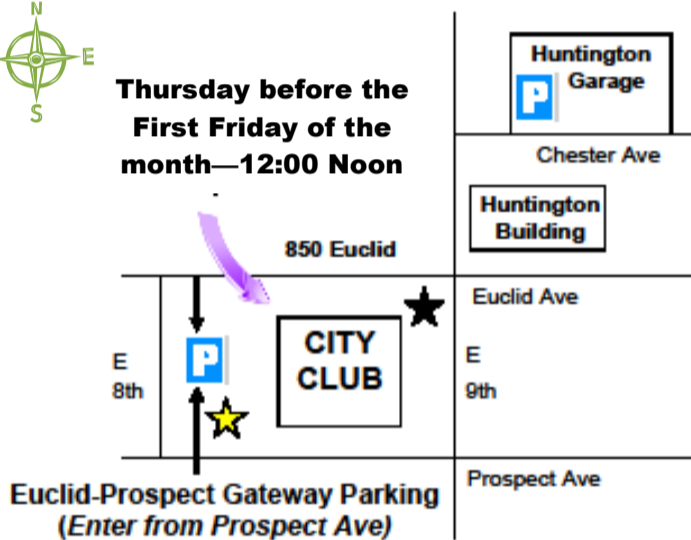

Departure: Go up to 3rd Floor and take walkway to the garage. Take garage elevator down to the Ground Floor or drive vehicle down to Ground Floor and turn left into short-term parking area. Go into glass-enclosed room where automated machines are located. Insert the validated parking ticket into one of the machines (cash only to the left, cash or credit to the right). Use this paid receipt at the automated machine to exit the garage. Turn right to Prospect; turn left to Euclid.
