In assisting a person to present a petition, the procurator has a special opportunity to teach, support, guide, and be an instrument of healing.

WHO MAY BE A PROCURATOR?

Our program is open to certified pastoral minister/associates, those in the certification process, and the ordained. **Required of those who will be attending is a prior course in canon law.**
