- Share content (photos/videos) of how your school teaches & practices our Catholic faith

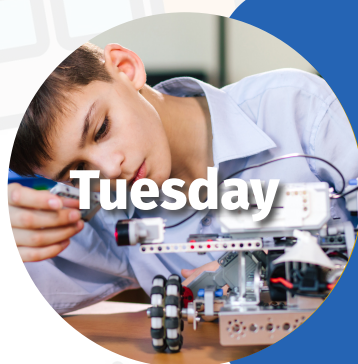
WHAT WE LOVE
