Who: Open to all educators: teachers, staff, trustees and administrators, in preK-12, higher education or adult education, from Catholic, public, private, charter, or community settings. This includes clergy, pastoral staff, coaches, child care workers and **all those who shape learning for others**, whether paid or not.

Why: *Remember why you became an educator in the first place.* Trying to sustain yourself and thrive in the midst of heavy demands? Discerning decisions or direction? Professional development through *reflective practices* feeds hope & resilience.

How: In large-group, small-group, and solitary settings, “the heart of a teacher” is explored, making use of insights from storytellers, poets, seasonal metaphors, various wisdom traditions, personal stories, and reflections on classroom practice. Skilled facilitators create an open, hospitable, reflective, focused space—a [Circle of Trust](#) — which invites the noise within us and around us to subside.

Where: Jesuit Retreat Center (JRC), Parma Ohio

When: 6pm Friday July 12 - 1pm Sunday July 14

Tuition includes meals, lodging (single occupancy), program and materials. Full-Tuition/ Institutional Rate: \$550. Partial Scholarships Rate: \$290 for those who request scholarships; and **for the first 10 from Catholic institutions in the Diocese of Cleveland**. Further financial aid & payment plans are available due to anonymous donors' underwriting.

Discounts: 1) **Early registration \$40 discount for all before May 31.** 2) From full tuition, 5% for your **2nd** retreat in Ohio, 10% for your **3rd** retreat and 15% for your **4th** retreat. Discounts combinable.

Application Process: There are 3 easy steps to the application 1) register online, 2) provide a short personal statement, and 3) submit \$50 application fee. The application fee is applied to the total tuition per participant. (Fee is refunded if you are not accepted.)

Deadline: Applications are fielded until 22 spots are filled, or **June 28**. Most Ohio retreats have more applicants than spaces. **Early deadline: May 31**
