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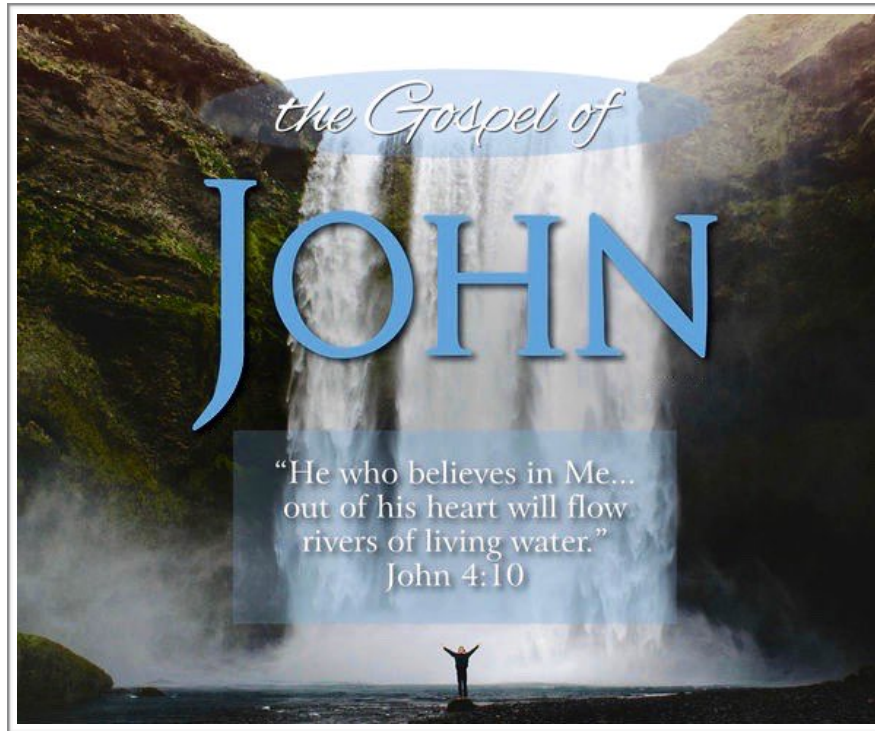

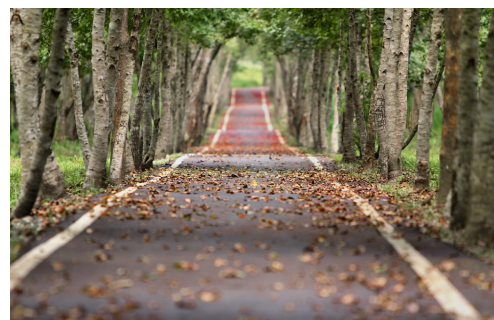

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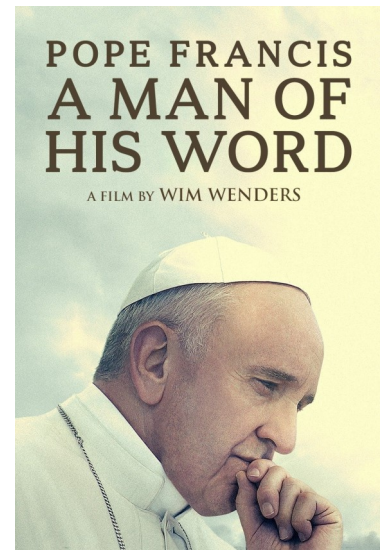

### Bob DiBiasio, Sr. Vice President, Public Affairs, the Cleveland Indians *Talking Baseball; Talking Tribe*

Join us at our April Luncheon when we welcome guest speaker Bob DiBiasio, Sr. Vice President of Public Affairs for the Cleveland Indians.

Bob DiBiasio is in his 40<sup>th</sup> season with the Cleveland Indians and his 41<sup>st</sup> in Major League Baseball in 2019. He started w/the Tribe in 1979 as Assistant PR Director, was named PR Director in 1980; and Vice President of PR in 1988. The Lakewood, OH native was promoted to his current position in 2011. His lone season away from the Tribe was 1987 when he served as PR Chief for the Atlanta Braves.



DiBiasio serves as President of Cleveland Indians Charities. He is an honorary member of the Executive Board of the Boys and Girls Clubs of Cleveland—serves on the Athletic Advisory Board of Notre Dame College (OH); is a member of the Board of Directors of the Cuyahoga County Public Library Foundation, the Bob Feller Act of Valor Foundation and the Baseball Heritage Museum at League Park.

DiBiasio is the host of the popular “Indians Alumni Roundtable Show” on STO, as well as “Tribe Tales” – a where-are-they-now segment that airs pre-game every Sunday on the Indians Radio Network. He was the 1999 recipient of the prestigious Robert O. Fishel Award for Public Relations Excellence in Major League Baseball. He was inducted into the Lakewood High School Distinguished Alumni Hall of Fame in 1999. In 1986, DiBiasio was named the Public Relations Director to Sports Illustrated’s Dream Team.

Bob and his wife, Penny, reside in Solon, OH; they have two adult children-daughter, Julie (Matt), and son, Patrick (Liz).

Dear Catholic School Teachers, Parish Catechist, Parish Employees, Employees of Catholic Agencies,

It is with immense pleasure that I write to inform you about a new initiative at Ursuline College. The Educational Administration and Theology and Pastoral Studies departments are offering special scholarships to Catholic school teachers, parish catechist, parish employees and employees of Catholic agencies who wish to pursue a master's degree in Educational Administration, a principal's or superintendent's license, or a master's degree in Theology and Pastoral Studies.

The National Catholic Education Association (NCEA) has published a report encouraging Diocesan school officials to develop succession plans so that personnel are available to assume leadership roles at individual schools and Diocesan offices as vacancies occur. The Ursuline College initiative has been shared with the Diocese of Cleveland Superintendent and Associate Superintendent. They are supportive of our initiative.

Currently Ursuline graduates serve as principals in more than 50% of the Diocesan elementary schools. Ursuline graduates also serve as administrators in 13 Diocesan high schools. We want to continue to do our part to prepare administrators for Catholic schools. The Educational Administration and Theology and Pastoral Studies programs already have a 40% cost reduction from the graduate tuition. In addition, Catholic agency employees will receive the following reductions:

- For each of the first five course taken in a program, the individual would receive \$300.00 off each course.
- For courses 6-10 taken in a program, an individual would receive \$400.00 off each course.
- For courses 11-15 taken in the program, an individual would receive \$500.00 off each course.

Please post and/or distribute the attached flyer to all appropriate people. Also, please encourage individuals you see as leaders to begin to walk this path. It is important that our future Catholic leaders receive their training from a place that honors Catholic School Education and that prepares individuals for employment in Catholic agencies.

Ursuline is ready to enroll individuals for the summer semester that begins May 13.

This six-part series introduces key themes in moral theology from the perspective of economics of the body in a variety of guises. Aimed at building a strong theological framework and skills for dialoguing about critical moral issues in the world today, the series will consider the following topics:

- **Economic Trinity as a Model of Creaturely Being**  
This unit introduces the idea of mutuality in relationship as inseparable from the Christian conception of God and from the biblical teaching of human beings as made in God's image
- **Oikonomia in Historical Perspective**  
This unit builds on the idea of relationship in and among households, examining moral issues in gender, sex, family, and families-in-society
- **Debt and Forgiveness**  
This unit imagines contemporary applications of the classical Christian language of debt and forgiveness, shedding new possibilities for thinking today about the sacrifice of Jesus
- **Living Wages and the Cost of Sin**  
This unit examines the costs of life and death in juxtaposing theological and secular valuations of human work, sacrifice, and profit
- **The Poor We Will Always Have**  
This unit examines the theological option for the poor and Christian teachings and practices around poverty and material wealth
- **Economies of the Body**  
This unit will bring together a cumulative discussion of bodies in fundamental moral perspective, emphasizing the need for a constructive 21st century theology of Christian oikonomia



**Natalie Kertes Weaver, Ph.D.**, is Professor of Religious Studies and co-director of Graduate Theology and Pastoral Studies at Ursuline College in Pepper Pike, Ohio. She is an international speaker and frequently published author. Her areas of interest and expertise include feminist theology, sexual ethics; theology of suffering and death, theology of the family, and theology and music. Her current works in development include *Intersex* and *Theological Anthropology and Theology and Music*.

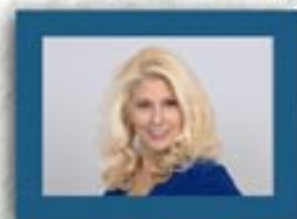

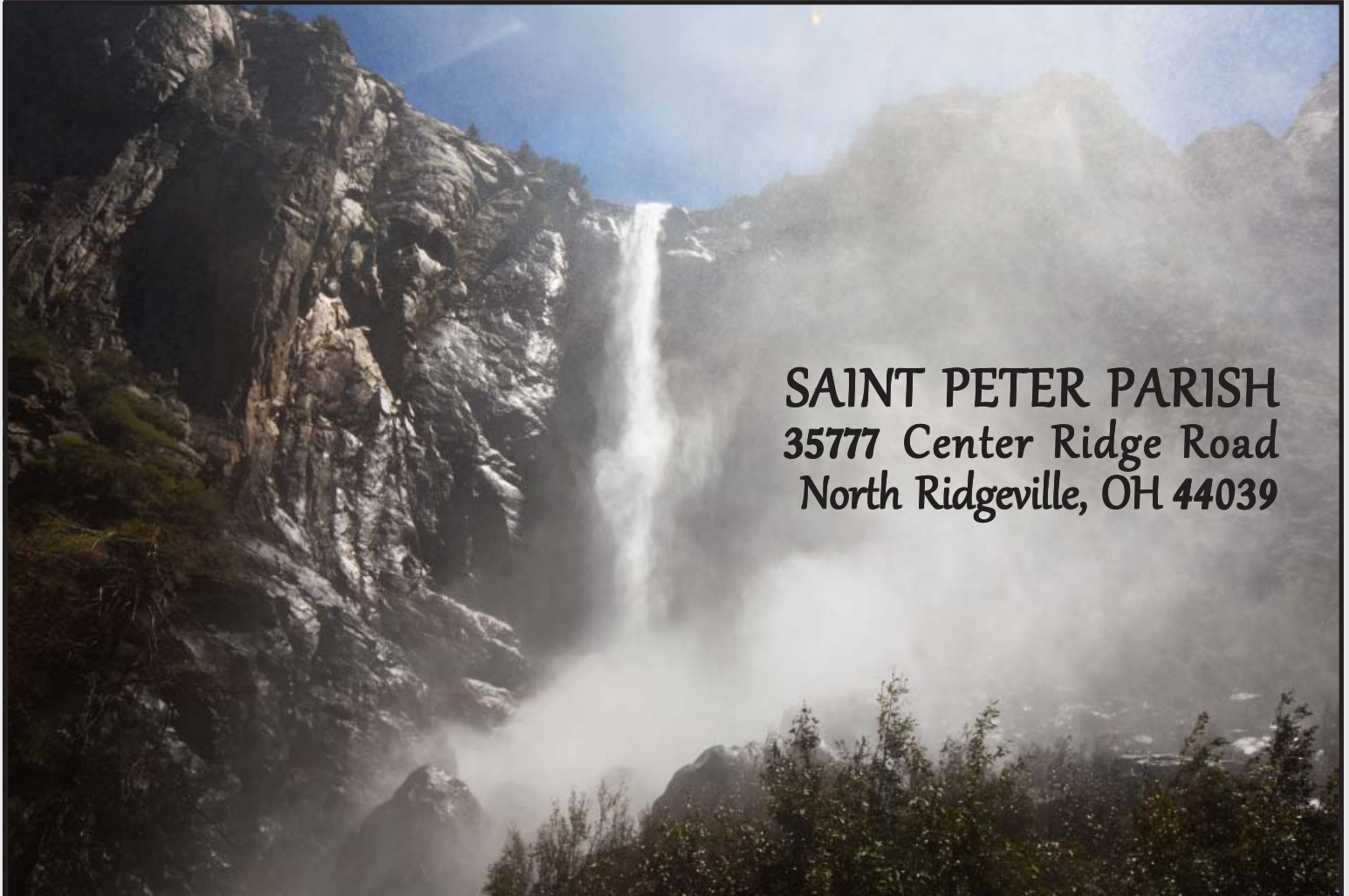
