

## ITINERARY.

**DAYS 1 & 2 :** Depart Cleveland for Lisbon. Upon arrival in Lisbon, we will transfer to Fatima. After dinner we will participate in the Rosary and Candlelight procession

**DAY 3:** We visit the Basilica and the Chapel of the Apparitions in Fatima and Valinhos, where Mary appeared in 1917 after the visionaries were released from prison, and Aljustrel, the hamlet where they lived. We depart late afternoon for Vigo

**Day 4:** Porriño to Redondela (15 km/10 miles) Our first morning of the Camino we will pass the chapel of Las Angustias and several Romanesque chapels including Santa Maria, Santa Eulalia and Santiaguño de Antas before crossing the Atlantic Puente de Rande

**Day 5:** Redondela to Pontevedra, (19 km/13 miles) Today we stop at the 16th century church of Santiago, cross a bridge famous for hosting many battles during the French occupation, enter the churches of Santa Maria, La Peregrina, with it's statue of Mary dressed as a pilgrim, and stroll through the Alameda park

**Day 6:** Pontevedra to Caldas de Reis, (23 km/15 miles) During today's walk, we pass through eucalyptus and pine forests where we will view several "cruceros", Galician monuments marking the presence of the dead in the world of the living. We will also stop at the 13th century church of San Martín

**Day 7:** Caldas de Reis to Padrón, (19 km/13 miles) Before leaving Caldas, we visit the church of Santa María de Caldas, the. Continue to the village of Santa Marina de Carracedo where we will see the "hórreos", wood or stone granaries used to store potatoes, corn, cereal and to dry meat. We will arrive in Padrón, where the stone boat carrying the body of

St. James arrived and were transferred by his disciples to Santiago de Compostela

**Day 8:** From Padrón to Santiago de Compostela, (24 km/16 miles) Our last day of walking we will pass by Iria Flavia, an ancient episcopal see, and visit the church where Nobel laureate Camilo José Cela was baptized before passing through A Escravitude, Faramello and Milladoiro

**DAY 9:** In the morning we will receive the Compostela, then attend the pilgrim Mass. We will have a short period of time for lunch and to explore the heart of the historical center of Santiago before our trip back to Lisbon

**DAY 10:** We will enjoy a walking tour of Lisbon's old quarter, the Alfama, Santo António Church (built on the site of the childhood home of St. Anthony of Padua) and the 12th century Cathedral before partaking in the WYD Opening Ceremonies

**DAY 11 :** We have morning catechesis, followed by the WYD Youth Festival events

**DAY 12:** After morning catechesis, we attend the welcoming ceremonies for Pope Francis

**DAY 13:** Today's events include catechesis, the festival and the Via Crucis with Pope Francis

**DAY 14:** We partake in the pilgrimage walk, evening prayer vigil with Pope Francis and a night sleeping under the stars

**DAY 15:** Morning Mass with Pope Francis followed by an afternoon departure for Cleveland
