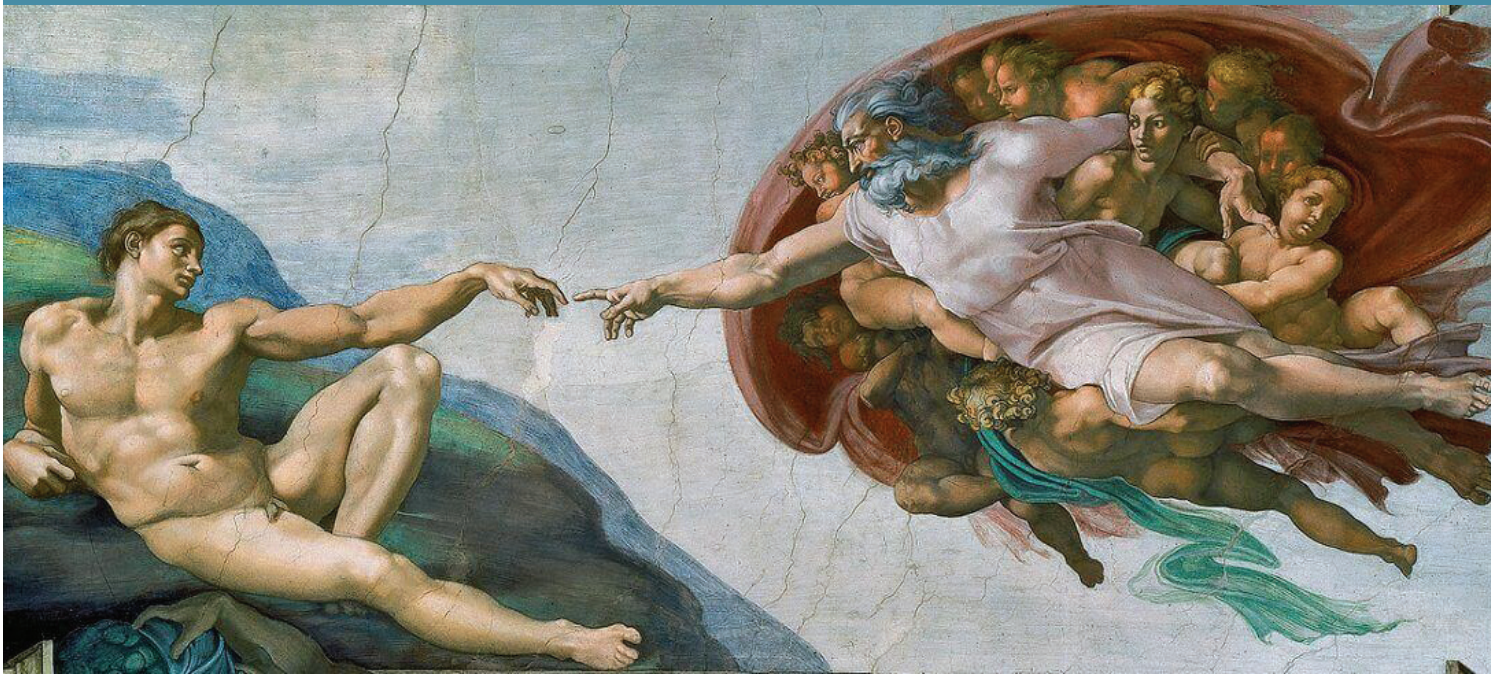

DR. LOGAN GAGE Professor of Philosophy, Director of the M.A. program in Catholic Studies at Franciscan University of Steubenville

Logan Paul Gage is Professor of Philosophy and Director of the M.A. program in Catholic Studies at Franciscan University of Steubenville, and he is a contributing author to *God's Grandeur: The Catholic Case for Intelligent Design*. His academic work focuses primarily on natural theology and epistemology. He is currently writing a book on the epistemology of John Henry Newman.

Dr. Gage will speak on "Aquinas and Intelligent Design" on Saturday at 2:00pm and on Friday afternoon at 4pm for our high school students.



FR. MARTIN HILBERT C.O., M.A.S.C., PH.D., Lecturer in the philosophy of science at St. Philip's Seminary, Toronto, Canada Born in Prague, Czechoslovakia, Martin Hilbert migrated to Canada as a child following the Soviet invasion.

He has an M.A.S.C. in electrical engineering and a PhD in the history and philosophy of science from the University of Toronto. Hilbert studied for the priesthood at St. Philip's Seminary, where he now teaches a course in the philosophy of science. He is a priest of the Oratory of St. Philip Neri in Toronto and presently the pastor of Holy Family Church.

Fr. Hilbert will speak on "Evolution and Original Sin" on Saturday at 10:30 am.



DR. JOHN WEST Vice President, Discovery Institute; award-winning author and documentary film maker

John G. West is Vice President of the Seattle-based Discovery Institute and Managing Director of the Institute's Center for Science and Culture. Formerly the Chair of the Department of Political Science and Geography at Seattle Pacific University, West is an award-winning author and documentary filmmaker who has written or edited 12 books, including *Darwin Day in America: How Our Politics and Culture Have Been Dehumanized in the Name of Science*, *The Magician's Twin: C. S. Lewis on Science, Scientism, and Society*, and *Walt Disney and Live Action: The Disney Studio's Live-Action Features of the 1950s and 60s*. His next book is *Stockholm Syndrome Christianity: Why America's Christian Leaders are Failing—and What We Can Do About It* (forthcoming, 2025). His documentary films include *Fire-Maker*, *Revolutionary*, *The War on Humans*, and (most recently) *Human Zoos*. West holds a PhD in Government from Claremont Graduate University, and he has been interviewed by media outlets such as CNN, Fox News, Reuters, Time magazine, The New York Times, USA Today, and The Washington Post. DR. BRIAN MILLER Research Coordinator and Senior Fellow for the Center for Science and Culture at the Discovery Institute

Brian Miller is a contributing author to the book *God's Grandeur: The Catholic Case for Intelligent Design*. He holds a B.S. in physics with a minor in engineering from MIT and a PhD in physics from Duke University. He speaks internationally on the topics of intelligent design and the impact of worldviews on society, and helps manage the ID 3.0 Research Program, having been a primary organizer of the Conference on Engineering in the Life Sciences (CELS). He also has consulted on organizational development and strategic planning, and he is a technical consultant for TheStartup, a virtual incubator dedicated to bringing innovation to the marketplace. He has contributed to multiple books and journals covering the debate over intelligent design, including *The Mystery of Life's Origin: The Continuing Controversy*, *The Comprehensive Guide to Science and Faith*, and *Inference Review*. He is a regular contributor to *Evolution News & Science Today*, and the *ID the Future Podcast*.

Dr. Miller will speak on "The Intelligent Design of the Universe" on Friday evening at 8:30pm, and on "The Intelligent Design of Life" on Saturday morning at 9:30am. He will also speak to our high school students at 2pm on Friday.

Randy Malick holds a Master's in Christian Ministry from Franciscan University in Steubenville, Ohio, completed most of his course work for a Master's in Divinity at St. Vincent Seminary in Latrobe, Pennsylvania, and has a Bachelor's of Fine Arts from the University of Akron. He has been involved in ministry for his entire adult life, first in performing, then in an international pro-life ministry and finally in parish ministry for the last 30 years. Randy has also worked in advertising, TV and radio. He particularly enjoys playing C.S. Lewis in *Symbol or Substance*, and as a stand alone.
